A. BASIC TERMS

2	Name of Competition	<p>Big Stage. #Meroket Ke Bintang</p>
3	Brief Description of Competition	<p>Big Stage is a reality television program aimed at spotlighting the next generation of rising stars in the music industry, affectionately known as "Budak Baru Nak Up" (BBNU). The show provides a platform for young, aspiring singers with exceptional talent who have yet to achieve significant breakthroughs in their careers.</p> <p>The Competition commences with 10 contestants in Episode 1, who may be solo artists, duos, or trio, but will be judged individually based on their unique talent and charisma. Throughout the season, contestants will reside together for the duration of the Competition, as announced by the Organizer, and will participate in various challenges and collaborations that test their ability to adapt, perform, and work cohesively with others.</p> <p>As the season progresses, contestants with the lowest scores in the designated concerts will be eliminated.</p>
4	Brief mechanism of Competition	<p>The Competition will be conducted as follows:</p> <p><u>1. Online Audition/Scouting for Contestants</u></p> <p>(a) To be eligible, participant must have at least one piece of content - such as a performance video, cover, skit, or any talent showcase: - that has gained significant traction on social media, either on their own platforms or public platforms.</p> <p>(b) Shortlisted participant will then be invited to an on-ground audition, where their performance will be evaluated by the show's producers and a panel of judges.</p> <p><u>2. On-Ground Audition</u></p> <p>(a) Each Participant is required to register by completing and submitting the official Registration Form, which will be provided at the registration counter on-site to the Organizer.</p> <p>(b) The On-Ground Audition stage is open to:</p> <p>(a) Fast Lane Pass Holders: Individuals who have submitted their applications online.</p> <p>(b) Walk-in Participants: Individuals without a Fast Lane Pass.</p> <p><u>3. Audition Requirements</u></p> <p>(a) Eligibility: Open to male and female participants aged 18 to 30 years as of January 1, 2026.</p> <p>(b) Height Requirement: Participants must have a minimum height of 160 cm (male) and 155cm (female)</p> <p>(c) Participation Type: Open to solo performers, duos and trios.</p> <p>(d) Photo Submission: Participants must bring a 4R-sized photo or a passport-sized photo.</p>

		<p>(e) Performance Materials: Participants must provide their own minus one track for two songs of different genres.</p> <p>(f) Additional Skills: Ability to dance and play instrument.</p> <p><u>4. The On-Ground Audition Stage is divided into two (2) rounds:</u></p> <p>(a) Round 1: Each Participant is required to perform at least one (1) song. Performances will be evaluated by a panel of judges appointed by the Organiser. Participants who meet the required standards will be shortlisted to proceed to Round 2.</p> <p>(b) Round 2: Shortlisted participants must deliver at least one (1) singing performance and will undergo further evaluation based on the instructions provided by the Appointed Judges and the Organiser.</p> <p><u>5. Participants in both Round 1 and Round 2 will be assessed using the following scoring criteria:</u></p> <p>(a) Singing ability;</p> <p>(b) Performance;</p> <p>(c) Creativity; and</p> <p>(d) Character and personality.</p> <p><u>Concert 1-6 (Weekly Concerts).</u></p> <p>1) 10 shortlisted contestants will compete in the Competition.</p> <p>2) All Contestants are required to perform based on their individual talent.</p> <p>3) Their performances will be 100% judged by 2 appointed permanent juries and 1 guest jury.</p> <p>4) Contestants must agree if organizer decides to make changes or re-organize the groups throughout the show.</p> <p><u>Concert 7 (Final Concert).</u></p> <p>1) Only 6 contestants will perform.</p> <p>2) The Contestants performances will be 100% judged by 2 appointed permanent juries and 1 guest jury.</p> <p>3) Champion of the Competition is based from the highest marks.</p> <p>The Contestants must adhere to the mechanism of the Competition as may be briefed and communicated to the contestants by the organizer during the Competition Period.</p>
5	Eligibility Criteria	<p>1) The Competition is open exclusively to Malaysian citizens, permanent residents, and nationals of Brunei, Indonesia, Singapore, and South Korea. For clarity, please refer to the detailed eligibility criteria below.</p> <p>Eligibility Criteria for All Participants</p> <p>(a) The Competition is open to male participants aged between 18 and 30 years as of January 1, 2026.</p> <p>(b) Height Requirement: Participants must have a minimum height of 160 cm (male) and 155cm (female)</p> <p>(c) The Competition is open to solo performers, duos, and trio.</p> <p>(d) Participants are required to bring a 4R-sized or passport-sized photo.</p> <p>(e) Participants must provide their own minus-one tracks for two songs from different genres.</p> <p>(f) Additional Skills: Ability to dance and play instrument.</p> <p>2) For Malaysian Citizens, Permanent Residents, and Valid Visa Holders:</p>

		<p>(a) Participants must attend the on-ground auditions and present their Malaysian National Registration Identity Cards (NRIC), passport, or international passport.</p> <p>3) For Non-Malaysian Citizens:</p> <p>(a) Non-citizen Participants are required to submit a video audition. Additional videos may be requested by the Organiser as part of the application process. Online auditions are available for non-citizens.</p> <p>4) Additional Eligibility Requirements:</p> <p>(g) Participants must not have been convicted of any criminal offense as of the date of application, nor are they currently under investigation or facing charges for any criminal offenses (excluding road traffic offenses).</p> <p>(h) Participants must not have been declared bankrupt within the preceding six (6) years or be currently involved in any bankruptcy proceedings as of the date of application.</p>
6	Ineligibility	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Any individual who does not meet the eligibility requirements outlined in the Eligibility Criteria section will be deemed ineligible to participate in the Competition. 2. Employees of the Organiser, the Producer, and their respective subsidiaries and affiliated companies, as well as their <i>immediate family members</i>. 3. Employees of the official Sponsors of the Competition, and their immediate family members. 4. <i>Immediate family members</i> of the juries involved in the Competition. 5. Participants who have participated in previous seasons of the "Big Stage" Competition are ineligible to participate in the current season. <p><i>Immediate family members</i> are defined as a spouse, children, parents, brothers, and sisters, inclusive of adoptive family members.</p>
7	Age of Eligibility	Participants must be at least 18 years old and not above 30 years old as of 1st January 2026.
8	Competition Period	<p>Audition: 2nd and 3rd May 2026 Concert: 28 June 2026 – 9th August 2026 (7 weeks)</p> <p>The Organiser reserves the right to amend, postpone or re-schedule the Competition Period or any of the dates thereof at its sole discretion.</p>
9	Language of Competition	The Competition will be organised and produced by the Organiser in Bahasa Melayu and English language.
10	Entry Procedure	<p>By invitation, extended to potential candidates scouted by the Organizer, or through an open walk-in process.</p> <p>The Organizer will determine whether candidates attend the on-ground audition or, for international candidates not based in Malaysia, the online audition.</p> <p>Participants must fill in the application form provided at the registration counter during the on-ground audition day or, for international candidates not based in Malaysia, via online.</p> <p>The Organiser shall be entitled to request to sight the original Identity Card or the originals of other supporting documents/materials for verification purposes.</p>

11	Entry Deadline	<p>Entries must be received by the Organiser during the audition day and before the registration counter is closed. Entries received before the commencement of the Show Period and after the stipulated Entry Deadline will be disqualified and ineligible for participation.</p> <p>Commencement of the Show Period is currently set to 28 June 2026, but is subject to change at the Organiser's sole discretion.</p>
12	Mode	<p>1. Audition:</p> <p>(a) Malaysian Citizens:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On-Ground Audition Malaysian citizens are required to participate in the On-Ground Audition, where they must physically attend the audition event as set forth by the Organiser. Such participants must present their valid Malaysian National Registration Identity Card (NRIC) or passport as proof of citizenship. <p>(a) Malaysia and Non-Malaysian Citizens:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Online/Video Audition Non-Malaysian citizens are not eligible to participate in the On-Ground Audition. Instead, they must submit their audition materials through the Online/Video Audition process. Non-citizen participants are required to submit a video audition and may be asked to submit additional videos at the Organiser's discretion. • Open to Malaysian to submit their video online before proceed to ground audition. <p>(b) For both Malaysian citizens and non-Malaysian citizens, the Organiser reserves the right to request further documentation or clarification to verify eligibility, and failure to provide such materials will result in ineligibility to participate in the Competition.</p> <p>(c) Both Malaysian citizens and non-Malaysian citizens may be invited to participate in a Closed Audition, an exclusive selection round. The details of the Closed Audition, including the venue, date, and participation requirements, will be communicated by the Organiser to those who successfully meet the initial screening criteria.</p> <p>2. Concert</p> <p>(a) All Contestants are required to be physically present on the designated date for the On-Ground Concert. Failure to attend may result in disqualification or ineligibility for that round of the Competition. The Organiser retains the right to adjust the dates, and contestants will be informed of any changes.</p>
13	Address	At the specific location to be advised by the Organiser
14	Selection of Winner	Winners will be selected based on the format of the Competition.
15	Prize	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Champion: RM30,000.00 only • 2nd place: RM20,000 only • 3rd place: RM10,000 only • 4th place: RM5,000 only • 5th place: RM5,000 only <p>Prizes must be shared if the contestants are in duo or trio.</p>
16	Notification of winners	The winner will be announced by the Organiser at the end of the Final Concert.

17	Collection Period	Within three (3) months from the notification by the Organiser
18	Collection Venue	All Asia Broadcast Centre, Technology Park Malaysia, Lebuhraya Puchong-Sungai Besi, Bukit Jalil, 57000 Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. Or any venue to be advised by the Organiser.
19	Additional Terms, if any	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Selected Contestants <u>must</u> participate in all segments during the Competition. No substitution or replacement of any of the Contestants is permitted at any time during the Competition. In the case of any emergencies or unavoidable or unforeseen circumstances, the Organiser in its sole and absolute discretion may allow a contestant to exit from the Competition. 2. Where a Contestant is selected in the Competition, the Contestant must be able to take time off from their daily activities at a time that is required by the Organiser at its sole discretion. 3. During the Competition Period, all Contestants are not allowed to participate in any other form of other gameshow or competition, whether similar in substance and/or format to the Competition or otherwise, unless with the Organiser's express consent. 4. Contestants must be free from any contractual obligation / arrangement or any other legal encumbrance, which may prevent him/her from participating in this Competition and/or entering a possible service or management contract with the Organiser and/or its affiliates after the Competition Period. 5. The Organiser reserves the right to change the format and/or mechanism of the Competition at any time during the Competition Period at its sole discretion.

The Competition Basic Terms and Conditions ("Basic Terms"), the Competition Standard Terms and Conditions (collectively "s") and the Privacy Notice shall be binding on all contestants who participate in this Competition ("**Participants**"). The definitions in the Competition Standard Terms and Conditions shall apply unless otherwise expressly agreed in the Competition Basic Terms and Conditions.
