A. BASIC TERMS

3	Name of Game Show	Mualim Muda Season 2
4	Brief Description of Game Show	Mualim Muda Season 2 returns with a renewed vision to discover and nurture a new generation of young Muslim leaders who embody strong Islamic knowledge, exemplary character, and inspiring leadership. Building on the success of its inaugural season, the Game Show continues to serve as a platform for talented young Muslim men with Islamic educational backgrounds to emerge as positive role models for the community and society at large. The Game Show begins in Episode 1 with 10 individual contestants ("Contestants"). Each week, the Contestants shall undertake structured challenges and be evaluated based on their knowledge, charisma, and overall performance by a professional panel of judges comprising one (1) Head of Jury, one (1) Permanent Jury, and one (1) Guest Jury (collectively referred to as the "Jury Panel"). Throughout the Game Show, Contestants will live together while participating in a series of challenges and collaborative activities designed to test their critical thinking, adaptability, performance skills, and ability to work both independently and as part of a team. As the Game Show progresses, Contestants with the lowest weekly scores will be eliminated. In the finale, the remaining Contestants will compete in a final live presentation performance, culminating in the announcement of the champion of the Game Show.
5	Brief Mechanism of Game Show	The Game Show will be conducted as follows: A. <u>AUDITION</u> <u>Stage 1: Online Submission</u> (a) Contestants who meet the eligibility criteria specified in Clause 6 below ("Contestants") are eligible to participate in the Online Submission by: (i) scanning the official QR code available on the official website for the Game Show, 'salammuslim.com.my' ("Official Website"), as well as on

		promotional posters, television promotional advertisements (TV promos), and/or other promotional materials or platforms as designated by the Organiser from time to time, which will direct the Contestants to the online entry form; and (ii) completing and submitting the online entry form to register their participation. (b) Upon successful registration, Contestants shall be required to submit a minimum of one (1) video comprising the following components, with a maximum duration of five (5) minutes per video ("Entry Video"): (i) a brief self-introduction; (ii) recitation of Surah Al-Fatihah; and (iii) a short Islamic speech addressing a contemporary issue. (c) Contestants shall submit their most recently created and recorded Entry Video, produced specifically for the purposes of this Game Show. The Entry Video shall be submitted to the Organiser via any of the following methods: (i) by uploading the Entry Video to the Contestants' personal social media account(s) (e.g., Instagram, Facebook and TikTok), accompanied by the mandatory hashtag #MualimMuda2026. Contestants are encouraged to tag the Game Show's social media platforms(s) using the handle '@mysalammuslim' ("Official Social Media Platforms") when uploading the Entry Video. Contestants shall ensure that their social media account(s) be set to public throughout the Game Show period stipulated in Clause 8 below; or (ii) by sending the Entry Video to the Organiser's designated email address at mualimmuda@astro.com.my with the subject line "Mualim Muda 2026". (d) Submission of an Entry Video does not guarantee selection, shortlisting or participation in the on-ground audition. All Entry Video shall be reviewed and evaluated by the Organiser and/or the Jury Panel based on criteria as the Organiser may determine at its sole and absolute discretion, and the Contestants whose Entry Video are deemed suitable by the Organiser and/or Jury Panel will be shortlisted and invited to an on-ground audition with a Fast Lane Pass ("Fast Lane Pass Holders"). (e) The purpose of this Online Submission stage is to grant successful Contestants a 'Fast Lane Pass' which will be utilised during the on-ground audition. The Organiser reserves the right to request further documentation, clarification and/or materials from Contestants to verify eligibility and suitability of Contestants to participate in the Game Show, and failure to provide the foregoing may result in ineligibility to participate in the Game Show. (f) The Organiser reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to accept or reject any Entry Video and/or Online Submission, to shortlist or not shortlist any Contestant, and to determine the number of Contestants selected to receive the Fast Lane Pass. The Organiser's decision shall be final, conclusive and binding, and no correspondence, explanation or appeal shall be entertained. <u>Stage 2: On-Ground Audition</u> (a) The On-Ground Audition stage is open to the following categories of Contestants (collectively, the "On-Ground Contestants"): (i) Fast Lane Pass Holders; (ii) Walk-in Contestants who do not hold Fast Lane Pass; and (iii) Contestants who were not shortlisted or selected during the Online Submission stage, or who did not receive an official notification from the Organiser. (b) Round 1 (Live Evaluation): Save and except for the Fast Lane Pass Holders, all other On-Ground Contestants shall undergo Round 1 (Live Evaluation), whereby they must first complete the registration process
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		for the On-Ground Audition by: (i) being physically present at the designated audition venue during the specified registration hours. Details of the On-Ground Audition will be notified by the Organiser via the Official Website, Official Social Media Platforms, television promotional announcements, and/or direct communication channels, including email or short messaging services (SMS/WhatsApp); (ii) completing and executing the hard copy application form provided at the registration counter; (iii) presenting their original Malaysian National Registration Identity Card (NRIC) and/or birth certificate for verification and profiling by the Organiser; and (iv) delivering a live presentation before the Jury Panel, comprising the following components, with a maximum duration of five (5) minutes per performance: (aa) a brief self-introduction; (bb) recitation of Surah Al-Fatihah; and (cc) a short Islamic speech addressing a contemporary issue. Contestants who pass this Round 1 (Live Evaluation) will advance to Round 2 (Final Screening) along with the Fast Lane Pass Holders. For the avoidance of doubt, the Fast Lane Pass Holders are exempted from Round 1 (Live Evaluation) and shall proceed directly to Round 2 (Final Screening) as set out below. (c) Round 2 (Final Screening): All Contestants who successfully pass Round 1 (Live Evaluation), together with the Fast Lane Pass Holders, shall undergo Round 2 (Final Screening) whereby they will be subject to the following advanced evaluation and performance requirements: (i) delivering a short Islamic speech in multiple languages; (ii) responding to basic and contemporary Islamic knowledge questions; and (iii) any further advanced operational directives as may be issued by the Jury Panel and the Organiser from time to time. (d) Scoring Criteria: The scoring criteria for the On-Ground Audition (applicable to both Round 1 (Live Evaluation) and Round 2 (Final Screening)) shall be as follows: (i) Qur'an recitation (<i>tajweed</i> and <i>taranum</i>); (ii) Islamic knowledge and religious understanding; (iii) Multilingual proficiency; (iv) Technical and content quality of the Entry Video (if applicable); (v) Live presentation performance; (vi) Creativity and engagement; and (vii) Character, manners (<i>akhlaq</i>), and personality. (i) Final Selection & Backup Pool: Ten (10) Contestants will be selected for the main competitive episodes. All selected Contestants shall have three (3) Business Days from notification by the Organiser to confirm their participation in the Game Show. Any Contestant who withdraws or fails to confirm within this period will be replaced by a backup Contestant at the Organiser's sole discretion. B. <u>MAIN SHOWS (WEEKS 1–7)</u> (a) Format: Each week, Contestants will be tasked with two (2) core challenges for the Jury Panel's evaluation and scoring: (i) On-Ground Task: An individual performance or challenge assessing real-world application; and (ii) On-Stage Task: A live presentation performance encompassing Surah recitation and public speaking on assigned topics. (b) Elimination Process: Contestants shall be evaluated on a weekly basis. Three (3) Contestants with the lowest scores will be placed in the "Bottom Three" and Contestant whose scores are the lowest amongst
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		the three shall be eliminated. (c) Judging Authority & Tie-Breaker: All challenges (on-Ground Task and On-Stage Task) throughout the Game Show Period shall be evaluated exclusively (100%) by the Jury Panel. There shall be no public, SMS, or online voting. In the event of a tie between two (2) or more Contestants, the following tie-breaker protocol shall apply in strict order of precedence to determine the final ranking or elimination: (i) The higher score awarded by Head of Jury shall prevail; (ii) Should the tie persist, the higher score awarded by Permanent Jury 1 shall prevail; and (iii) Should the tie still persists, the higher score awarded by Permanent Jury 2 shall prevail. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Head of Jury shall retain the sole and absolute discretion to make a final, overriding, and binding decision to break any deadlock or determine the final ranking or elimination status of the tied Contestants. C. <u>GRAND FINALE (WEEK 8)</u> (a) Finalists: Only four (4) remaining Contestants will advance to the Grand Finale to fulfil individual final assignments (“Finalist(s)”). (b) Champion Determination: Finalists will be evaluated 100% by the Jury Panel. The Finalist with the highest cumulative score will be declared the champion of the Game Show. (c) Grand Finale Tie-Breaker: In the event of a tie score for the position of Champion or any subsequent runner-up placements, the tie shall be resolved in accordance with the protocol established below: (i) The higher score awarded by the Head of Jury shall prevail; (ii) Should the tie persist, the higher score awarded by Permanent Jury 1 shall prevail; and (iii) Should the tie still persist, the higher score awarded by Permanent Jury 2 shall prevail. The Head of Jury shall have the sole and absolute discretion to issue a final, definitive, and binding decision to break any tie and declare the champion of the Game Show. (d) Collective Recognition: All Contestants who reached the Weekly Main Show stage will be presented and collectively recognised under the prestigious title of Mualim Muda, honoring their overall development and religious contribution. D. <u>COMPLIANCE AND COMPULSORY PRODUCTION SCHEDULES</u> All Contestants must comply stringently with the operational structure, timelines, and live production schedules outlined below: (a) Main Shows and Grand Finale Live Broadcasts Attendance: Contestants must be physically present at the designated production venue on the specified dates. Unexcused absence or tardiness will lead to immediate disqualification. The Organiser reserves the right to amend the specified dates with reasonable notice: Week 1: Rehearsal: 16 October 2026 (Friday) Main Show: 17 October 2026 (Saturday) Week 2: Rehearsal: 23 October 2026 (Friday) Main Show: 24 October 2026 (Saturday) Week 3: Rehearsal: 30 October 2026 (Friday) Main Show: 31 October 2026 (Saturday) Week 4: Main Show: 7 November 2026 (Saturday) Week 5: Main Show: 14 November 2026 (Saturday) Week 6: Main Show: 21 November 2026 (Saturday) Week 7: Main Show: 28 November 2026 (Saturday)
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		Week 8 (Finale): Rehearsal: 4 December 2026 (Friday) Main Show: 5 December 2026 (Saturday) (b) Class / Training Sessions Attendance: Contestants must maintain a 100% physical attendance record at the designated residential academy or training venues for compulsory educational modules, training clinics, and technical rehearsals. (c) Compulsory Academy Period: A continuous period from 7 October 2026 to 5 December 2026, during which Contestants shall be required to participate in all Game Show-related activities and/or challenges as determined by the Organiser.
6	Eligibility Criteria	(a) National Status: Open exclusively to Malaysian citizens. (b) Demographics: Male Contestants aged between 18 and 35 years old calculated precisely as of 1 January 2026. (c) Participation Style: Solo/individual entries only. (d) Competency Foundations: Possession of a solid foundation in basic Islamic knowledge and religious concepts. Multilingual proficiency is highly advantageous. (e) Required Documentation: Contestants must present a valid Malaysian National Registration Identity Card (NRIC) and/or official Birth Certificate during registration. (f) Background Verification: (i) Contestants must not have been convicted of any criminal offense as of the date of application, nor are they currently under investigation or facing charges for any criminal offenses (excluding road traffic offenses). (ii) Contestants must not have been declared bankrupt within the preceding six (6) years or be currently involved in any bankruptcy proceedings as of the date of application.
7	Ineligibility	The following parties are explicitly barred from participating in the Game Show: (a) Employees of the Organiser, the Producer, their respective corporate subsidiaries, holding companies, and affiliates, including immediate family members. (b) Employees and immediate family members of the official commercial sponsors of the Game Show. (c) Jury Panel of the Game Show, including their immediate family members. (d) Top 10 former contestants of Mualim Muda Season 1. Note: "<i>Immediate family members</i>" strictly denotes spouses, children, biological or legal parents, brothers, and sisters (inclusive of legally adopted family members)
8	Game Show Period	• Online Submission: 16 July 2026 – 11 August 2026 • On-Ground Audition: 15 August 2026 & 16 August 2026 • Main Shows and Grand Finale (Live Broadcasts): 17 October 2026 – 5 December 2026 <i>The Organiser reserves the absolute right to alter, extend, postpone, or reschedule any phase of the Game Show Period at its sole discretion.</i>

9	Language of Game Show	The Game Show will be organised, scripted, and produced primarily in Bahasa Melayu and English . Contestants must demonstrate fluency and comfort performing across both languages.
10	Entry Procedure	As set out in Clauses 5, 8, 11 and 12.
11	Entry Deadline	All applications must be fully received by the Organiser before the formal closure of the registration counter on the specified audition days. Submissions outside the specified period will be rendered void.
12	Mode of Participation	(a) Audition (Online Submission and On-Ground Audition): Contestants shall participate in the audition process in the format and at the venue designated by the Organiser, which may include physical auditions, virtual/online submissions, or live streaming evaluations. Contestants must comply with all technical requirements, time limits, and performance criteria set by the Jury Panel and the Organiser. Progression to subsequent stages is subject to the absolute selection and discretion of the Organiser. (b) Class / Training Sessions: Contestants selected to advance shall undergo compulsory educational modules, training clinics, and rehearsal sessions ("Class Sessions"). The Class Sessions may be conducted via physical attendance at a designated academy/venue, residential bootcamps, or via digital/online learning platforms, as determined by the Organiser. Full active participation and strict adherence to the curriculum, schedule, and instructors' directives are mandatory. (c) Main Show and Grand Finale (Live Broadcasts): Contestants/Finalists shall participate in the production of the main competitive episode consisting of studio recordings, outdoor challenges, and/or live broadcasts. Contestants must be fully available for the entirety of the production cycle, including pre-show technical rehearsals, wardrobe fittings, and post-show media debriefs. The Organiser reserves the right to alter the format, broadcast medium, filming schedules, and tracking mechanisms of the Main Show and Grand Finale at any time during the Game Show Period at the Organiser's sole discretion. (d) Other Commitments & Exclusivity: Contestants shall fully commit to and attend all recordings, live shows, promotional events, press conferences, and any other related activities as requested by the Organiser. Failure to comply with such scheduled requirements without valid written justification shall entitle the Organiser to disqualify the Contestants with immediate effect.
14	Production Venue	At specific locations and broadcast studios within Malaysia to be officially advised by the Organiser.
15	Selection of Winners	Winners will be determined strictly according to the official format and scoring matrices of the Game Show. The Organiser's decision is final, absolute, and non-appealable. No correspondence, queries, or legal appeals will be entertained.
16	Prize	• Champion: RM30,000.00 cash only. • 2nd, 3rd, & 4th places Finalists: RM5,000.00 cash only for each Finalist
17	Notification of Winners	Winners will be announced live on air by the Organiser at the conclusion of the Grand Finale.

18	Collection Period	All cash prizes must be claimed within three (3) months from the date of the live announcement, subject to the Winners providing verified bank accounts and valid identity documentation. Unclaimed prizes after this period will be irrevocably forfeited.
19	Collection Venue	All Asia Broadcast Centre, Technology Park Malaysia, Lebuhraya Puchong-Sungai Besi, Bukit Jalil, 57000 Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, or any alternate venue advised by the Organiser.
20	Additional Terms, if any	(a) Continuous Commitment: Contestants shall participate in all segments, tasks, and sub-activities of the Game Show. No substitution, replacement, or proxy shall be permitted under any circumstances once the Game Show has commenced. In cases of documented medical emergencies or other severe unforeseen circumstances, the Organiser may, at its sole and absolute discretion, permit a Contestant to exit the Game Show without penalty. (b) Leave of Absence: By agreeing to participate, Contestants warrant that they have secured all necessary leave of absence from their employer, educational institution, or other commitments to accommodate the production schedule and requirements of the Organiser. (c) Game Show Exclusivity: During the active Game Show period, Contestants shall not enter, register for, or appear in any other television game show, broadcast programme, digital content competition, or talent search across any media platform without the Organiser's prior written consent. (d) Freedom to Contract: Contestants warrant that they are not subject to any pre-existing management agreements, exclusive recording contracts, or other legal encumbrances that would restrict their participation in the Game Show or prevent them from entering into a management or talent services agreement with the Organiser and/or its affiliates upon conclusion of the Game Show. (e) Format Variations: The Organiser reserves the sole and absolute discretion to alter, modify, adjust, or revise the mechanics, scoring rules, and overall format of the Game Show at any time during the production lifecycle to enhance or optimise broadcast quality.

The Game Show Basic Terms and Conditions ("Basic Terms"), the Game Show Standard Terms and Conditions (collectively "**Terms and Conditions**") and the Privacy Notice shall be binding on all contestants who participate in this Game Show ("Contestant"). The definitions in the Game Show Standard Terms and Conditions shall apply unless otherwise expressly agreed in the Game Show Basic Terms and Conditions. In the event of any inconsistency between the Game Show Standard Terms and Conditions, the Game Show Basic Terms and Conditions and the Privacy Notice, the Game Show Basic Terms and Conditions shall prevail to the extent of such inconsistency.

Entry and participation in the Game Show shall be deemed unconditional acceptance by the Contestants of the Terms and Conditions and the Privacy Notice.
